Class2 2'6" – 2'9" maximum. (Speed 450mpm)

Class 3 2'9" – 3'0" maximum (Speed 450mpm)

Class 4 3'0" – 3'3" maximum (speed 475mpm)

Prizes 1st £25 2nd £15 3rd £10 Rosettes to 10th place

Entry Fee £25 per Class

A Horse / Pony may only do 2 classes

All entries must be paid for in advance. All entry fees include vat @ 20%

The Competition will be a combination of show jumps (7 -10 fences) and Straight out onto the cross-country fences (15 -28 efforts)

The winner being closest to the optimum time on the cross – country with the least penalties. Show jumping times will count if equal scores on the X.C phase.

NO STOP WATCHES

Cross – Country dress code. Approved hard hats (non fixed peaks) and Body Protectors are compulsory for all competitors.

Medical Arm Bands must be worn (there will be a few available on the day at a cost of £6)

A £5 refundable deposit will be required for number bibs

2. Use of the Facilities and practice areas is entirely at your own risk.
3. 3. Approved hard hats must be worn and secured at all times when mounted. PAS 015, BSEN 1384, EN1384, ASTM F1163, SNELL E2001.
4. Body protectors of Level 3 (Purple Label) must be worn. (those manufactured in the year 200 or after are recommended but not compulsory)
5. The Judges decision is final.
6. Any objections to be lodged with the show secretary in writing within 30 min of the end of the class with a £10 deposit. If the objection is upheld the deposit will be refunded.
7. All Animals must be correctly restrained, Dogs to be kept on leads, horses must not be left tied to vehicles unattended
8. All Competitors should have adequate insurance cover for both horse and rider

Penalties for the Cross-country Phase

- First Disobedience at a jump.....20 penalties
- Second disobedience at the same jump.....40 penalties
- Third disobedience at the same jump.....Elimination
- Fourth disobedience on the whole courseElimination
- Fall of rider at a fence.....65 penalties
- Second fall of rider on the course.....Elimination
- Fall of Pony/Horse at a fence.....Elimination
- Error of course (omission of jump, boundary flag etc) not rectified, retaking an obstacle already jumped... .. Elimination
- Trapped Pony/Horse.....Elimination
- Inappropriate or dangerous ridingDiscretionary Elimination
