Classes

Class one:	70cm Individual	<i>Qualifier for Eland Lodge 2021</i>
Class two:	70cm Pairs	
Class three:	Non-competitive individual chance to jump a mix of 70 or 80cm jumps around the course *	
Class four:	80cm Individual	<i>Qualifier for Eland Lodge 2021</i>
Class five:	80cm Pairs	<i>Qualifier for Eland Lodge 2021</i>
Class six:	Non-competitive individual chance to jump a mix of 80 or 90cm jumps around the course *	
Class seven:	90cm Individual	<i>Qualifier for Eland Lodge 2021</i>
Class eight:	90 cm Pairs	

* **NOTE – if riders go on from these classes to enter either the 80cm or 90cm classes, they must do so as a non-competitive entry as they will have experienced the course already. Given the lack of events this year, we have added these classes so riders have an opportunity to try some larger fences on a course.**

Entry Fees:

Classes 1, 3, 4, 6, 7	£30 SDRC Member	£34.50 Individual Non-Member
Classes 2, 5, 8	£48 Pairs SDRC Members	£58 Pairs Non-Members

Booking Process:

- Entries will be through Horse Monkey <https://horsemonkey.com/>
 - Entries accepted up to 8pm 2nd September 2020.
 - Standard fees apply to midnight on 24th August 2020.
 - £5 late entry fee applies from 25th August 2020.
 - In addition to your entry fee a **£5 starting fee per individual competitor** (not class) is payable to contribute to the cost of medical cover. To minimise contact at the event and follow Covid-19 guidance, the starting fee is to be paid **in advance** on HorseMonkey and will be refunded if the rider does not compete in any class on the day.
 - If the event is cancelled for any reason after the closing date of 24th August 2020, your entry fees will be refunded less £10 administration fee, to contribute towards the costs we will not be able to recoup.

- Tie-up for horses will only be allowed on 1 side of each lorry / trailer
- If any of the Covid-19 guidelines for competitors are not adhered to on the day, competitors will be politely asked to leave the event and will forfeit their entry/start fees.
